<p>Wildlife Hospital</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Direct care of wildlife patients. Prepare food for animals, feed baby birds and mammals, assist with exams and medical treatments, clean cages, wash dishes, and do laundry. Must be able to lift up to 20 pounds.• Time Commitment: Volunteers commit to their (1) four hour shift each week. The shifts are 9 AM to 1 PM, 1 PM to 5 PM, and 5 PM to 9 PM - 7 days a week. Volunteers commit to 1 set shift. For example, the Monday evening 5pm-9pm shift could be your shift through the spring/summer. Our wildlife hospital only has two full-time staff members. For this reason, we require reliability of our volunteers, as they are our staff.
<p>Wildlife Hospital Reception</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Answer incoming calls and provide wildlife information, assist with office work, and welcome individuals bringing in wildlife.• Time Commitment: Volunteers commit to their (1) four hour shift each week. The shifts are 9 AM to 1 PM, 1 PM to 5 PM, and 5 PM to 9 PM - 7 days a week. Volunteer commit to 1 set shift. For example, the Monday evening 5pm-9pm shift could be your shift through the spring/summer. Our wildlife hospital only has two full-time staff members. For this reason, we require reliability of our volunteers, as they are our staff.
<p>Nature Center Assistant</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Greeting visitors/guests/education participants and vendors with a warm welcome and general summary of Cedar Run for those new to our Refuge. Keeping the Nature Center and its gift shop organized, clean and stocked. Answering phones. Assisting with mailings.• Time Commitment: As needed, scheduled by Nature Center staff.
<p>Outreach/Fundraising</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assistance with event planning and creating. Approaching retailers to hang our promotional materials, coordinate pick-up for donated items, set-ups, ability to transport items for events. Fundraising assistance, such as Autumn with the Animals. Attending the events. Assisting online postings (social media, etc.)• Time Commitment: As needed, scheduled by Donor Relations Manager
<p>Education Team</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Summer Camp CITs</u> - Assist our counselors with our summer day camps.<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Time Commitment: Camps run late June to early August (Mon-Fri, for ages 3-13). Half day program (ages 3-6). Full day program (ages 7-13)• <u>Bird Team</u>: Maintain the health and well-being of the birds used in our education programs. NOTE: You must have prior raptor handling experience OR experience in our Wildlife Hospital prior to being considered for the Bird Team.<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Time Commitment: 3 hours per week (scheduled by Education Team)• <u>Education Programs and Festivals</u>: Provide assistance to Education Team on education programs and festivals.<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Time Commitment: As needed, scheduled by Education Team
<p>Facilities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Assisting our Facilities Manager with projects including the repair of our Wildlife Hospital, Nature Center, and animal enclosures. Also assist in the construction of new animal housing.• Time Commitment: As needed, scheduled by Facilities Manager
