All Counselors are First Aid and CPR certified, required to pass a background check, and have experience working with children in camp and outdoor settings. They are integral to our mission to inspire kids to explore, respect and protect nature.





A Day at Camp

Cedar Run offers week-long camp sessions that run from June 24 to August 16.

Although each day at camp is different—creepy crawlies to find, tracks to follow, rainy day puddles to jump in—here's an idea of what you can expect.

- 8:45-9:15 am- Camper drop-off and free time
- 9:15 am- Opening activities and intro to the day's theme
- 9:45 am- Exploratory hikes, lessons, hands-on experiments, snack
- 12:00 pm- Pick-up for half-day campers; Lunch and free time for full-day campers
- 1:00 pm- Traditional camp games, hikes, crafts
- 2:45 pm- End of the day wrap-up, journals
- · 3:00 pm- Full-day camper pick-up
- 3:00-4:00pm- Aftercare available for full-day campers for an additional fee

What creatures lurk in the waters of Cedar Run? Campers will explore the puddles, ponds and swamps. We will follow a frog's footsteps, find bugeating plants and see what else awaits us. It will be a wild and wet week of mysterious creatures and water wonders.

Are your campers ready for an unforgettable adventure? With their team they will explore Cedar Run and find themselves challenged to "survive" a week in the Pines. Campers will build a survival shelter in the woods, use a map and compass, go in search of the Jersey Devil and see some animals too!

Jersey Devil Adventure

June 24-28 9:00am-3:00pm

Do you have what it takes to survive the Pinelands at night? During this short week of camp, campers will take their survival skills to the next level! During the day we will hone our skills with fun activities and exciting adventures.

On Thursday, bring a tent and stay for the night! We'll provide dinner over a campfire, go on a hike in the dark, and camp overnight under the stars and pines!

Earth Avengers

July 15-19 9:00am-3:00pm

Discover all you can about the different habitats and animals at Cedar Run. Explore underground, high in the sky and everywhere in between. Campers will work to complete a special conservation project at the Refuge.

On Thursday, bring a tent and spend the night! After dinner over the fire, we'll explore the woods in the dark, and see who might be hanging out with us before we camp under the stars!





STEAM Camps

In these special interest camps, we will engage in STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math) and nature inspired activities and experiments. Nature exploration with modern technology opens the door for real-world applications and exciting adventures.

K-5th grade

Discovery by the Day

July 1-5*, August 12-16 9:00am-3:00pm

Cedar Run understands that some families can't commit to a full week. With our "Discovery by the Day" sessions, you can sign-up for whichever days you'd like to accommodate your scheduling needs. New activities are planned each day so each child can participate. This is a combined group for campers entering grades K-5th only.

Daily themes:

- Monday- Wildlife Wanderings
- Tuesday- Wild About Art and Experiments
- Wednesday- Eww Bugs!
- Thursday- Survival Adventures
- Friday- Water, Water Everywhere

*Camps will run as normal on Thursday, July 4th.





Important Details

- Grade is determined by the grade level your child is entering in September 2024.
- Payment in full is due at the time of registration, which includes a \$35 nonrefundable processing fee per registration as part of your total.
- Registration must be fully submitted by midnight on 4/15/2024 to receive the Early Bird Discount.
- Online registration includes a health form and waiver that must be completed for each camper <u>two</u> weeks before the start of camp.
- Sessions for grades 2-8 can
 accommodate a maximum of 20
 campers; grades K-1 a max of 15; preK
 a max of 12. Sign-up early to
 guarantee your spot!

Camper Requirements

Due to the outdoor and exploratory nature of our camp program, campers must be able to move about on uneven terrain.

Campers are expected to meaningfully participate in age-appropriate activities, including nature study. All campers must follow stated behavior expectations and safety rules.

The Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss a camper when in their judgment the camper's behavior interferes with the rights of others, or the smooth functioning of the group or activity, or violates the camp's behavior policy. In such cases, no refunds will be provided. If you have questions regarding your child's ability to participate in our camp program, please contact the Camp Director.

Registration Information

Registration Confirmation

A confirmation email containing important documents and information will be sent once your camper's registration has been processed. Please allow 5-10 business days to process.

Session Transfers

Session transfer requests will be honored, if there is space available, and if a request is made at least two weeks prior to the session start date, after which transfers are not permitted.

Prorate Policy

Cedar Run camps run on a weekly basis and registrations are for the full week.
Cedar Run will not prorate camp weeks with the exception of the Discovery by the Day camp weeks.



Cancellation Policy

Cedar Run reserves the right to cancel a camp session due to insufficient enrollment. If Cedar Run cancels a session, all fees will be fully refunded. If you remove your child from a camp session before it begins, refunds are as follows:

- A full refund (less the \$35 nonrefundable processing fee) will be issued if cancellation request is received no later than 30 days prior to the start of the child's scheduled camp.
- · A 50% refund will be issued if cancellation request is received 14 to 29 days prior to the start of the child's scheduled camp.
- No refund will be issued if cancellation request is received later than 14 days prior to the start of the child's scheduled camp.

Membership Discounts

Cedar Run members at the Family Level or above receive the discounted rate. To qualify, your membership must be current through your camper's last session, and you must be the parent, grandparent, or legal quardian of the camper being enrolled. Membership can be purchased, upgraded or renewed at the time of registration.

Financial Aid

Financial assistance is available based on need and available funds, and is generally limited to one session per child; however, all applications are considered.
